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Beauty Changes Lives and Circadia Award Sage Michaela Lucas "Timing is Everything" Spring 2022 Esthetics Scholarship Winners

Natalie explains that the scholarship will help alleviate some of the financial burden, and allow her to be an inspiration to others that they too can overcome any obstacle to pursue your passions.
